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Background

- 2010 Survey: audit of services and supports for immigrants in London and Middlesex, barriers to service access and service delivery gaps, promising practices
- Ongoing evaluation of the LMLIP: activities and output, event evaluations (e.g., community forums), quantification of in-kind contributions from partners

Why We Chose to Evaluate the Work of the LMLIP in 2013

- End of 3 year strategic plan (2010-2013): Repeat audit of services and supports for immigrants in London and Middlesex, and assess perceptions of the LMLIP by organizations in the community
- Developing new 3 year strategic plan (2013-2016):
 Assists in determining new or continuing priorities, suggests what may need more focus, helps identify gaps and opportunities
- Publishing results helps to support accountability to the community

Key Features of Methodology

- Online survey developed by an LMLIP advisory committee and researchers from the P2P
- Survey administered in June September 2013
- Organizations within London and Middlesex contacted and asked to have a representative complete the survey on behalf of the organization – one set of responses per organization
- Also advertised on the London immigration portal, with the link to the survey provided
- 69 organizations completed the survey



Range of Questions


- Services offered by the organization: type, percentage of clients who are immigrants, target group(s)

Local and Regional Planning and Collaboration among Multiple Stakeholders


To what extent are you familiar with the activities of the London and Middlesex Local Immigration Partnership?



To what extent has your organization participated in the London and Middlesex Local Immigration Partnership?




Do you think the London and Middlesex Local Immigration Partnership is relevant to the work going on in the community to support immigrants?




Coordination of Services

Do you think the London and Middlesex Local Immigration Partnership has increased the coordination of services for immigrants in London and Middlesex?




Enhancement of Services

Do you think that the London and Middlesex Local Immigration Partnership has improved the type of services that are offered to immigrants in London and Middlesex?




To what extent has your organization changed its delivery of services in response to the strategic planning and activities of the London and Middlesex Local Immigration Partnership?
