


Research Question

• What is the impact of the media's portrayal of refugees on people's perception of refugees?


Theoretical Assumptions

 Implicit Social Cognition Model of Media Priming (Arendt, 2013)






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
Procedure – Study 1

- Three different editorials based on those used to describe the Tamil refugees in 2010: bogus, terrorist, neutral
- Fictitious refugee group arriving by boat on the east coast of Canada: Sandirians
- Automatic dehumanization of refugees through association with animals: Sequential priming task




Media Article: Neutral

Effect of Reading Editorial on Automatic Dehumanization




- Higher values indicate more dehumanization
- Participants dehumanized refugees more than Canadians only after reading the bogus and terrorist editorials


Procedure – Study 2

- Four different editorials based on those used to describe the Tamil refugees in 2010: bogus, <u>victim</u>, neutral and control
- Fictitious refugee group arriving by boat on the east coast of Canada: Sandirians
- Automatic dehumanization of refugees through association with animals: Sequential priming task


Media Article: Victim




Media Article: Neutral

Effect of Reading Editorial on Automatic Dehumanization




- Higher values indicate more dehumanization
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Implications of this Research

- Uncovers processes involved in stigmatization and exclusion of refugees
- Media depictions of refugee-related events can promote dehumanization
- Evidence of automatic dehumanization of refugees: reading some of the common messages prevalent in the media can increase the automatic association between refugees and

animals



Implications of this Research

- Avoid the terms bogus, terrorists and even victims in political messaging when talking about refugees
- These terms can lead to automatic refugee dehumanization



Sequential Priming Procedure for Assessing Automatic Dehumanization

Computer screen

Prime: Refugee, Canadian or no prime

Human or animal pictures (positive or negative)

Conceptual Task:
Categorization as human or animal




Evaluative Task:

Categorization as positive or negative



Human Target Pictures (positive & negative)





Human Target Pictures: 4 positive (happiness & pride) & 4 negative (sadness & anger), male and female

Animal Target Pictures: 4 positive (baby seal, butterfly, dragonfly, ladybug) & 4 negative (cockroach, rat, fly, worms)
