


What is COA?

- + Over **220,000** participants served since inception.







- + Helping **youth** prepare for arrival in Canada







3.2 HEALTH CARE IN CANADA

In Canada, access to basic health care is free. If you came to Canada as a refugee, in your first few months, you will have access to health services through the Federal Interim Health Program.

Eventually, you will get a health insurance card from the province or territory where you live. Keep this card with you as you will need to show it every time you visit a doctor or go to a hospital or clinic.




"With how much you have to struggle, coming to a new country is not easy. I gave 18 interviews, and now I am employed and happy with my job. COA helped me prepare to work hard."

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


