

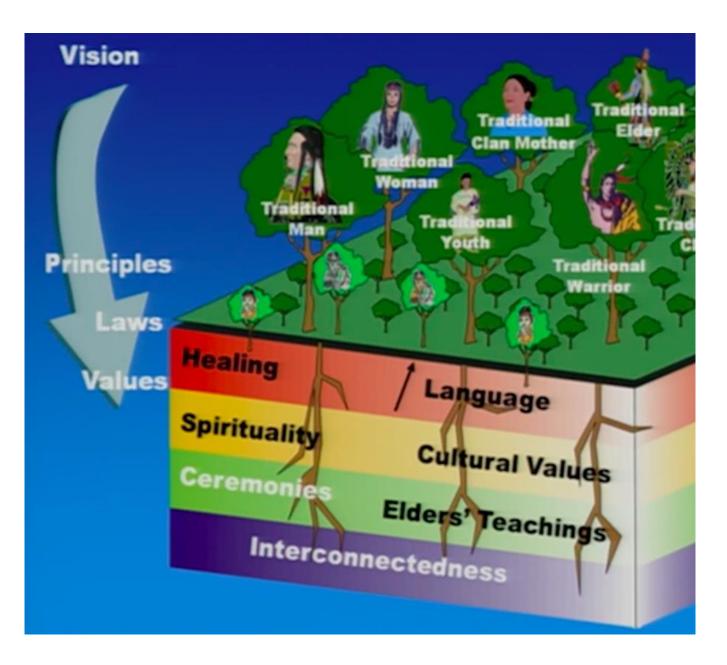

"The Brain Story" (AFWI course)





- 1. Issue is flagged by a member of the community (broker).
- 2. The issue is brought to me as a therapist (one of the knowledge holders) to explore further.
- 3. A small group of therapists meet to further explore the issue and we identify relationships as the key ingredient for mental health support
- 4. We design a participatory workshop to identify the 'magical ingredients' of transformative relationships.
- 5. The workshop is rolled out in a smaller group of senior cultural brokers. Feedback is incorporated into a 4 hour workshop for all the brokers, three weeks later.
- Learning and feedback from the workshop informs our mental health strategy moving forward. We begin to re-think our mental health strategy at the co-op (Therapist as mental health support for clients → Brokers and Therapists working more seamlessly to provide mental health support for clients).
